Job Description

This position would take the lead on

- Maintaining our **Affirming Church** status
 - by building relationships within our community, i.e. LGBTQIA2Spirit and other groups as they are identified.
- Assisting with **Indigenous Programs** and Education
 - Building relationships and listening to Indigenous Community needs to develop positive, empowering relationships with individuals, groups and organizations.
 - Truth and Reconciliation initiatives, including education and outreach opportunities to better engage the congregation (all ages) in the Truth and Reconciliation Calls to Action.
 - Coordination with Heart of Treaty 6 group.
 - Represent Grace United at Hot 6 gatherings, reporting and regularly sharing with the congregation.
- Educational events/programs relating to the above topics.
- Writing proposals, reports and grant applications as fits the position.
- Attend weekly staff meetings to enhance a larger team dynamic for the betterment of truth and reconciliation at Grace United in the community and beyond.

Qualifications

- Have experience working with the LGBTQIA2Spirit larger communities and with all Indigenous cultures.
- Have education or training in social justice issues, including indigenous awareness.
- Skills in developing and working in partnerships.
- Demonstrate strong organizational skills, with the ability to plan, set priorities and meet timelines.
- Excellent computer and communication skills.
- Be willing and supportive of working in a team situation.
- A United Church background would be considered an asset.
